| 12 | (2) include procedures to: |
| 13 | (A) verify the veteran status of each inmate |
| 14 | during the diagnostic process; and |
| 15 | (B) allow an inmate whose veteran status is |
| 16 | verified to opt in to the housing dedicated for use in the program |
| 17 | under Subdivision (1). |
| 18 | (b) A cellblock or dormitory dedicated for use in the |
| 19 | program under Subsection (a)(1) may, if necessary, be used to house |
| 20 | inmates who are not veterans. |
| 21 | SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date |
| 22 | of this Act, the Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall |
| 23 | establish the program required by Section 501.115, Government Code, |
