BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 46.04(e), Penal Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (e) An offense under Subsection (a) is a felony of the 8 <u>second</u> [third] degree. An offense under Subsection (a-1), (b), or 9 (c) is a Class A misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 10 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 11 12 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 13 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 14 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 15 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 16 before that date. 17
