C.S.H.B. No. 4882

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to a review by a local law enforcement agency of a school  
3 district's multihazard emergency operations plan.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 37.2071, Education Code, is amended by  
6 adding Subsections (a-1), (h-1), and (h-2) to read as follows:

7 (a-1) Before submitting a multihazard emergency operations  
8 plan to the center at the center's request under Subsection (b), a  
9 school district shall request provisional feedback from the center  
10 regarding the plan. The school district shall make adjustments to  
11 its plan as necessary.

12 (h-1) After approval of a plan by the center under this  
13 section, a school district shall submit its plan to an appropriate  
14 local law enforcement agency for review and to provide suggestions  
15 on the plan.

16 (h-2) For purposes of Subsection (h-1), an appropriate  
17 local law enforcement agency includes:

18 (1) a school district police department, if the  
19 district employs and commissions at least 20 full-time peace  
20 officers;

21 (2) the police department of a municipality in which  
22 the district is located;

23 (3) the emergency management agency of a county in  
24 which the district is located, if applicable; and

1           (4) the sheriff of the county in which the district is  
2 located.

3           SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024  
4 school year.

5           SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
9 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
