- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 19, Education Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 19.0052 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 19.0052. ADULT EDUCATION PILOT PROGRAM. (a) The
- 8 Windham School District shall establish a pilot program under which
- 9 one or more nonprofit entities provide an adult education program
- 10 under Subchapter G, Chapter 12, to enable persons described by
- 11 Subsection (b) to successfully complete a high school program that
- 12 can lead to a diploma.
- 13 (b) A person confined or imprisoned in the department who is
- 14 at least 26 years of age and not more than 50 years of age is
- 15 eligible to enroll in an adult education program operated under the
- 16 pilot program if the person:
- 17 (1) has failed to complete the curriculum requirements
- 18 for high school graduation;
- 19 (2) has failed to perform satisfactorily on an
- 20 assessment instrument required for high school graduation; or
- 21 (3) has failed to earn a high school equivalency
- 22 certificate.
- 23 (c) The district shall enter into a memorandum of
- 24 understanding with at least one nonprofit entity described by

- C.S.H.B. No. 4921
- 1 <u>Section 12.256</u>, <u>Education Code</u>, to <u>provide an adult education</u>
- 2 program under the pilot program. The district shall require the
- 3 nonprofit entity to identify each region of this state in which the
- 4 entity is able to operate an adult education program under the pilot
- 5 program.
- 6 (d) The district, in consultation with each nonprofit
- 7 entity with which the district enters into a memorandum of
- 8 understanding under this section, shall identify at least three
- 9 schools operated by the district that are suitable to serve as sites
- 10 for the pilot program.
- 11 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2024, the Windham
- 12 School District shall establish and implement the pilot program
- 13 required by Section 19.0052, Education Code, as added by this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
