1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the continuation of certain health care provider  
1-20 participation programs in certain counties.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section [292C.004](#), Health and Safety Code, is  
1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 292C.004. EXPIRATION. The authority of a county to  
1-25 administer and operate a program under this chapter expires  
1-26 December 31, 2027 ~~[2023]~~.

1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-28 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-29 provided by Section [39](#), Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-30 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
