6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Section 433.002(b), Government Code, is amended
8	to read as follows:
9	(b) The directive may provide for:
10	(1) control of public and private transportation in
11	the affected area;
12	(2) designation of specific zones in the affected area
13	in which, if necessary, the use and occupancy of buildings and
14	vehicles may be controlled;
15	(3) control of the movement of persons;
16	(4) control of places of amusement or assembly; and
17	(5) establishment of curfews[+
18	[(6) control of the sale, transportation, and use of
19	alcoholic beverages; and
20	[(7) control of the storage, use, and transportation
21	of explosives or flammable materials considered dangerous to public
22	safety, other than explosives or flammable materials that are

components of firearm ammunition].

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
