## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 148.011(c), Agriculture Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (c) The record must be prepared and made available to the
- 9 Texas Animal Health Commission and for public inspection within 24
- 10 hours after the slaughterer receives the livestock. The
- 11 slaughterer shall preserve the record for at least one year [two
- 12 years] and shall keep the record open for public inspection at all
- 13 reasonable hours.
- SECTION 2. Section 148.043(b), Agriculture Code, is amended
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 (b) A slaughterer shall <u>preserve the</u> [keep] records under
- 17 this section for at least one year and shall keep the record open
- 18 for public inspection at reasonable hours.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
