9	Sec. 249.001. STANDARD FOR NEW ELECTION. Notwithstanding
10	any other law, in a county with a population of more than one
11	million, the secretary of state shall order a new election if the
12	secretary has good cause to believe that at least two percent of the
13	total number of polling places in the county did not receive
14	supplemental ballots under Section 51.008 for one or more hours
15	after making a request for supplemental ballots to the authority
16	responsible for distributing election supplies.
17	Sec. 249.002. PROCEDURES FOR NEW ELECTION. In establishing
18	the procedures for a new election ordered under this chapter, the
19	secretary of state shall have the same authority granted to a
20	district court under Section 231.007.
21	Sec. 249.003. EXPENSES OF NEW ELECTION. The expenses of a
22	new election ordered by the secretary of state under this chapter
23	are paid from the same fund and by the same authority that paid the
24	expenses of the previous election.
