1	AN ACT
2	relating to the establishment of fair decision making policies by
3	metropolitan planning organizations.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 472, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 472.037 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 472.037. FAIR DECISION MAKING POLICY. (a) Each
8	metropolitan planning organization shall develop and implement a
9	policy for fair decision making in the organization's planning
10	process. In developing the policy, a metropolitan planning
11	organization shall:
12	(1) analyze the current representation and voting
13	structure of the organization's policy board and any existing
14	committees;
15	(2) consider:
16	(A) the current and projected population of the
17	area served by the organization; and
18	(B) the projected number of jobs that will be
19	created by each potential project considered by the organization;
20	(3) propose changes to ensure fair and proportional
21	representation on the organization's policy board and any existing
22	committees of:
23	(A) urban, suburban, and rural communities
24	served by the organization;

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1	(B) individuals served by the organization who do
2	not predominantly travel by passenger vehicle; and
3	(C) historically underrepresented and
4	underserved communities served by the organization; and
5	(4) establish guidelines to achieve fair
6	representation, including:
7	(A) proposing new joint powers agreements and
8	bylaws to remedy problems related to fair representation;
9	(B) guidance for adopting proportional voting
10	systems based on residential populations of areas represented by
11	the organization's policy board and any existing committees to
12	provide equal representation for all residents served by the
13	organization; and
14	(C) guidance for the organization to:
15	(i) include individuals from diverse
16	backgrounds on organization committees; and
17	(ii) ensure that the organization is
18	receiving input from individuals from diverse backgrounds that are
19	served by the organization.
20	(b) Not later than July 31, 2024, each metropolitan planning
21	organization shall submit a report to the department summarizing
22	the policy developed by the organization under Subsection (a).
23	This subsection expires August 31, 2024.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
