	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to release of an area from a municipality's
- 3 extraterritorial jurisdiction by petition or election.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 42, Local Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subchapters D and E to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER D. RELEASE OF AREA BY PETITION OF LANDOWNER OR RESIDENTS
- 8 FROM EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION
- 9 Sec. 42.101. AUTHORITY TO FILE PETITION FOR RELEASE. (a) A
- 10 resident of an area with a population of less than 200 in a
- 11 municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction may file a petition
- 12 with the municipality in accordance with this subchapter for the
- 13 <u>area to be released from the extraterritorial jurisdiction.</u>
- 14 (b) The owner or owners of the majority in value of an area
- 15 of land in a municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction may file
- 16 a petition with the municipality in accordance with this subchapter
- 17 for the area to be released from the extraterritorial jurisdiction.
- Sec. 42.102. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. Chapter 277,
- 19 Election Code, applies to a petition requesting removal under this
- 20 <u>subchapter</u>.
- Sec. 42.103. PETITION REQUIREMENTS. (a) A petition
- 22 requesting release under this subchapter must be signed by:
- 23 (1) more than 50 percent of the registered voters of
- 24 the area described by the petition as of the date of the preceding

- 1 uniform election date; or
- 2 (2) a majority in value of the holders of title of land
- 3 in the area described by the petition, as indicated by the tax rolls
- 4 of the central appraisal district.
- 5 (b) A person filing a petition under this subchapter must
- 6 satisfy the signature requirement described by Subsection (a) not
- 7 later than the 180th day after the date the first signature for the
- 8 petition is obtained.
- 9 (c) A signature collected under this section must be in
- 10 writing.
- 11 (d) The petition must include a map of the land to be
- 12 released and describe the boundaries of the land to be released by
- 13 metes and bounds or by lot and block number, if there is a recorded
- 14 map or plat.
- 15 Sec. 42.104. RESULTS OF PETITION. (a) A petition
- 16 requesting removal under this subchapter shall be verified by the
- 17 municipal secretary or other person responsible for verifying
- 18 signatures.
- 19 (b) The municipality must notify the residents or
- 20 landowners of the area described by the petition of the results of
- 21 the petition.
- 22 <u>(c) If a resident or landowner obtains the number of</u>
- 23 signatures on the petition required under Section 42.103 to release
- 24 the area from the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction,
- 25 the municipality shall immediately release the area from its
- 26 <u>extraterritorial jurisdiction</u>.
- Sec. 42.105. AREA NEAR MILITARY BASE. This subchapter does

- 1 not apply to any area located within five miles of the boundary of a
- 2 military base, as defined in Section 43.0117(a), in which an active
- 3 training program is conducted.
- 4 SUBCHAPTER E. RELEASE OF AREA BY ELECTION FROM
- 5 <u>EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION</u>
- 6 Sec. 42.151. AUTHORITY TO REQUEST ELECTION FOR RELEASE.
- 7 (a) A resident of an area with a population of 200 or more and that
- 8 has been in a municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction for at
- 9 least one year may request the municipality to hold an election in
- 10 accordance with this subchapter to vote on the question of whether
- 11 to release the area from the municipality's extraterritorial
- 12 jurisdiction by filing with the municipality a petition that
- 13 includes the signatures of at least five percent of the registered
- 14 voters residing in the area as of the date of the preceding uniform
- 15 election date.
- 16 (b) A resident may not request another election on the
- 17 question of releasing the same or substantially same area from the
- 18 municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction before the first
- 19 anniversary of the date the municipality receives a petition filed
- 20 under Subsection (a).
- 21 (c) The petition must include a map of the land to be
- 22 released and describe the boundaries of the land to be released by
- 23 metes and bounds or by lot and block number, if there is a recorded
- 24 map or plat.
- Sec. 42.152. ELECTION. (a) A municipality shall order an
- 26 <u>election on the question of whether to release an area from the</u>
- 27 municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction to be held on the

- 1 first uniform election date that falls on or after the 90th day
- 2 after the date the municipality receives a petition that complies
- 3 with Section 42.151.
- 4 (b) The municipality shall hold the election ordered under
- 5 this section in the area described by the petition at which the
- 6 qualified voters of the area described by the petition may vote on
- 7 the question of the release.
- 8 <u>(c) An election ordered under this section must be held in</u>
- 9 the same manner as general elections of the municipality. The
- 10 municipality shall pay for the costs of holding the election.
- 11 Sec. 42.153. RESULTS OF ELECTION. (a) Following an
- 12 election held under this subchapter, the municipality shall notify
- 13 the residents of the area proposed to be released from the
- 14 municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction of the results of the
- 15 election.
- 16 (b) If at the election held under this subchapter a majority
- 17 of qualified voters of the area to be released approve the proposed
- 18 release, the municipality shall immediately release the area for
- 19 which the election was held from the municipality's
- 20 extraterritorial jurisdiction.
- 21 Sec. 42.154. AREA NEAR MILITARY BASE. This subchapter does
- 22 not apply to any area located within five miles of the boundary of a
- 23 military base, as defined in Section 43.0117(a), in which an active
- 24 <u>training program is conducted.</u>
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
