8	HEALTH SERVICES. (a) In this section, "inpatient mental health
9	institution" means a hospital, nursing facility, or other
10	institution with 16 or more beds that primarily provides health
11	care services, including medical attention, nursing care, and
12	related services, to individuals with a mental illness.
13	(b) The commission shall ensure that medical assistance
14	reimbursement is provided to an inpatient mental health institution
15	that provides health care services to a recipient under the medical
16	assistance program.
17	(c) The executive commissioner by rule shall ensure that
18	medical assistance reimbursement provided under this section
19	includes reimbursement for:
20	(1) health care services provided to a recipient under
21	the medical assistance program regardless of the recipient's age;

23	(2) the entirety of a recipient's stay at an inpatient
24	mental health institution during which the institution provided

1 those services.

SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the waiver or authorization is granted.
