A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the certification of a historically underutilized 3 business.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 2161.252, Government Code, is amended as 6 follows:

Sec. 2161.252. AGENCY 7 DETERMINATION REGARDING SUBCONTRACTING OPPORTUNITIES; BUSINESS SUBCONTRACTING PLAN. (a) 8 9 Each state agency that considers entering into a contract with an expected value of \$100,000 or more shall, before the agency 10 11 solicits bids, proposals, offers, or other applicable expressions 12 of interest for the contract, determine whether there will be subcontracting opportunities under the contract. If the state 13 agency determines that there is that probability, the agency shall 14 require that each bid, proposal, offer, or other applicable 15 expression of interest for the contract include a historically 16 underutilized business subcontracting plan. 17

18 (b) The goal of each state agency historically 19 underutilized business subcontracting plan must reflect at least 20 the percentage of the ethnic population of the state.

21 (c) [(b)] When a state agency requires a historically 22 underutilized business subcontracting plan under Subsection (a), a 23 bid, proposal, offer, or other applicable expression of interest 24 for the contract must contain a plan to be considered responsive.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
