Section 533.0064(c), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (c) At the time the commission establishes a new program under the Medicaid program and not less frequently than annually, 8 the [The] commission shall review and identify the types of 9 providers for which an expedited credentialing process must be 10 11 established and implemented under this section. 12 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 13 14 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 15 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 16 waiver or authorization is granted. 17 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
