## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT relating to a study of stopped trains of excessive length that occupy railroad grade crossings for extended periods. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. (a) The Texas Department of Transportation shall study the disruption to vehicular travel and access to residences

7 caused by stopped trains of excessive length that occupy one or more 8 railroad grade crossings for extended periods. The study must 9 address the potential impact of legislation regulating:

10 (1) the maximum length of trains in this state, 11 including the minimum number of conductors that should be required 12 for trains based on length; and

13 (2) the period of time for which a stopped train may14 occupy a railroad grade crossing.

(b) Not later than March 1, 2024, the Texas Department of Transportation shall submit to the standing committees of the legislature having jurisdiction over railroads a report on the findings of the study.
