A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a proposition for certain school districts to be 3 prohibited from imposing an ad valorem tax and to be operated and 4 funded in the same manner as an open-enrollment charter school.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 11.301, Education Code, is amended by 7 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read 8 as follows:

9 (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section, a [A] 10 school district or county system operating under former Chapter 17, 11 18, 22, 25, 26, 27, or 28 on May 1, 1995, may continue to operate 12 under the applicable chapter as that chapter existed on that date 13 and under state law generally applicable to school districts that 14 does not conflict with that chapter.

(c) Notwithstanding any other law, not later than November 15 16 1, 2023, the board of directors of a school district operating under former Chapter 26, as that chapter existed on May 1, 1995, shall 17 order an election to be held on the first uniform election date that 18 allows sufficient time to comply with any requirements of law on the 19 question of prohibiting the district from imposing an ad valorem 20 21 tax and providing for the district to be operated and funded in the same manner as an open-enrollment charter school under Subchapter 22 23 D, Chapter 12.

(d) Notwithstanding any other law, if a majority of the

1	registered voters of the school district vote to approve the
2	proposition under Subsection (c):
3	(1) the board shall:
4	(A) notify the agency of the approval of the
5	proposition; and
6	(B) in coordination and consultation with the
7	agency, develop a transition plan approved by the agency to provide
8	for the district to be operated and funded in the same manner as an
9	open-enrollment charter school under Subchapter D, Chapter 12; and
10	(2) the district may not impose an ad valorem tax for
11	any purpose on or after the date on which the election was held.
12	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
