1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the creation of the Honey Creek Improvement District
1-20 No. 1; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to
1-21 impose assessments and fees.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-23 SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 4, Special District Local Laws
1-24 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 3796 to read as follows:

1-25 CHAPTER 3796. HONEY CREEK IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1

1-26 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1-27 Sec. 3796.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

1-28 (1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.

1-29 (2) "City" means the City of McKinney.

1-30 (3) "Director" means a board member.

1-31 (4) "District" means the Honey Creek Improvement

1-32 District No. 1.

1-33 Sec. 3796.0102. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The Honey Creek
1-34 Improvement District No. 1 is a special district created under
1-35 Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

1-36 Sec. 3796.0103. PURPOSE; DECLARATION OF INTENT. (a) The
1-37 creation of the district is essential to accomplish the purposes of
1-38 Sections 52 and 52-a, Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI,
1-39 Texas Constitution, and other public purposes stated in this
1-40 chapter.

1-41 (b) By creating the district and in authorizing the city and
1-42 other political subdivisions to contract with the district, the
1-43 legislature has established a program to accomplish the public
1-44 purposes set out in Section 52-a, Article III, Texas Constitution.

1-45 (c) The creation of the district is necessary to promote,
1-46 develop, encourage, and maintain employment, commerce,
1-47 transportation, housing, tourism, recreation, the arts,
1-48 entertainment, economic development, safety, and the public
1-49 welfare in the district.

1-50 (d) This chapter and the creation of the district may not be
1-51 interpreted to relieve the city from providing the level of
1-52 services provided as of the effective date of the Act enacting this
1-53 chapter to the area in the district. The district is created to
1-54 supplement and not to supplant city services provided in the
1-55 district.

1-56 Sec. 3796.0104. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE.

1-57 (a) All land and other property included in the district will
1-58 benefit from the improvements and services to be provided by the
1-59 district under powers conferred by Sections 52 and 52-a, Article
1-60 III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and other
1-61 powers granted under this chapter.

2-1 (b) The district is created to serve a public use and
2-2 benefit.

2-3 (c) The creation of the district is in the public interest
2-4 and is essential to further the public purposes of:

2-5 (1) developing and diversifying the economy of the
2-6 state;

2-7 (2) eliminating unemployment and underemployment; and

2-8 (3) developing or expanding transportation and
2-9 commerce.

2-10 (d) The district will:

2-11 (1) promote the health, safety, and general welfare of
2-12 residents, employers, potential employees, employees, visitors,
2-13 and consumers in the district, and of the public;

2-14 (2) provide needed funding for the district to
2-15 preserve, maintain, and enhance the economic health and vitality of
2-16 the district territory as a community and business center;

2-17 (3) promote the health, safety, welfare, and enjoyment
2-18 of the public by providing pedestrian ways and by landscaping and
2-19 developing certain areas in the district, which are necessary for
2-20 the restoration, preservation, and enhancement of scenic beauty;
2-21 and

2-22 (4) provide for water, wastewater, drainage, road, and
2-23 recreational facilities for the district.

2-24 (e) Pedestrian ways along or across a street, whether at
2-25 grade or above or below the surface, and street lighting, street
2-26 landscaping, parking, and street art objects are parts of and
2-27 necessary components of a street and are considered to be a street
2-28 or road improvement.

2-29 (f) The district will not act as the agent or
2-30 instrumentality of any private interest even though the district
2-31 will benefit many private interests as well as the public.

2-32 Sec. 3796.0105. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
2-33 district is initially composed of the territory described by
2-34 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.

2-35 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
2-36 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake in the
2-37 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
2-38 does not affect the district's:

2-39 (1) organization, existence, or validity;

2-40 (2) right to issue any type of bonds for the purposes
2-41 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and
2-42 interest on the bonds;

2-43 (3) right to impose or collect an assessment; or

2-44 (4) legality or operation.

2-45 Sec. 3796.0106. ELIGIBILITY FOR INCLUSION IN SPECIAL ZONES.
2-46 All or any part of the area of the district is eligible to be
2-47 included in:

2-48 (1) a tax increment reinvestment zone created under
2-49 Chapter 311, Tax Code; or

2-50 (2) a tax abatement reinvestment zone created under
2-51 Chapter 312, Tax Code.

2-52 Sec. 3796.0107. APPLICABILITY OF MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT
2-53 DISTRICTS LAW. Except as otherwise provided by this chapter,
2-54 Chapter 375, Local Government Code, applies to the district.

2-55 Sec. 3796.0108. PRECONDITION. (a) The district may not
2-56 exercise any powers granted to the district by this chapter or other
2-57 law unless a development agreement between the city and the primary
2-58 landowner in the district that establishes the standards that apply
2-59 to development in the district, in addition to those contained in
2-60 zoning, subdivision, and other applicable ordinances of the city,
2-61 has been executed.

2-62 (b) If a development agreement described by Subsection (a)
2-63 has not been executed before September 1, 2024, the board shall
2-64 dissolve the district in the manner provided by Subchapter I as soon
2-65 as possible after September 1, 2024.

2-66 Sec. 3796.0109. CONSTRUCTION OF CHAPTER. This chapter
2-67 shall be liberally construed in conformity with the findings and
2-68 purposes stated in this chapter.

SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Sec. 3796.0201. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is governed by a board of five elected directors who serve staggered terms of four years.

(b) Directors are elected in the manner provided by Subchapter D, Chapter 49, Water Code.

Sec. 3796.0202. COMPENSATION; EXPENSES. (a) The district may compensate each director in an amount not to exceed \$150 for each board meeting. The total amount of compensation for each director in one year may not exceed \$7,200.

(b) A director is entitled to reimbursement for necessary and reasonable expenses incurred in carrying out the duties and responsibilities of the board.

Sec. 3796.0203. INITIAL DIRECTORS. (a) The initial board consists of the following directors:

(b) Of the initial directors, the terms of directors appointed for positions one through three expire June 1, 2025, and the terms of directors appointed for positions four and five expire June 1, 2027.

SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

Sec. 3796.0301. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for which the district is created.

Sec. 3796.0302. IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND SERVICES. (a) The district, using any money available to the district for the purpose, may provide, design, construct, acquire, improve, relocate, operate, maintain, or finance an improvement project or service authorized under a development agreement described by Section 3796.0108, under this chapter, or under Chapter 375, Local Government Code.

(b) The district may contract with a governmental or private entity to carry out an action under Subsection (a).

(c) The implementation of a district project or service is a governmental function or service for the purposes of Chapter 791, Government Code.

Sec. 3796.0303. NONPROFIT CORPORATION. (a) The board by resolution may authorize the creation of a nonprofit corporation to assist and act for the district in implementing a project or providing a service authorized by this chapter.

(b) The nonprofit corporation:

(1) has each power of and is considered to be a local government corporation created under Subchapter D, Chapter 431, Transportation Code; and

(2) may implement any project and provide any service authorized by this chapter.

(c) The board shall appoint the board of directors of the nonprofit corporation. The board of directors of the nonprofit corporation shall serve in the same manner as the board of directors of a local government corporation created under Subchapter D, Chapter 431, Transportation Code, except that a board member is not required to reside in the district.

Sec. 3796.0304. MEMBERSHIP IN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS. The district may join and pay dues to a charitable or nonprofit organization that performs a service or provides an activity consistent with the furtherance of a district purpose.

Sec. 3796.0305. PARKING FACILITIES. (a) The district may acquire, lease as lessor or lessee, construct, develop, own, operate, and maintain parking facilities or a system of parking facilities, including lots, garages, parking terminals, or other structures or accommodations for parking motor vehicles off the streets and related appurtenances.

(b) The district's parking facilities serve the public purposes of the district and are owned, used, and held for a public

4-1 purpose even if leased or operated by a private entity for a term of
 4-2 years.

4-3 (c) The district's parking facilities are parts of and
 4-4 necessary components of a street and are considered to be a street
 4-5 or road improvement.

4-6 (d) The development and operation of the district's parking
 4-7 facilities may be considered an economic development program.

4-8 Sec. 3796.0306. ADDING OR EXCLUDING LAND. (a) Subject to
 4-9 Subsection (b), the district may add or exclude land in the manner
 4-10 provided by Subchapter J, Chapter 49, Water Code, or by Subchapter
 4-11 H, Chapter 54, Water Code.

4-12 (b) The district may add territory as described by
 4-13 Subsection (a) only if the governing body of the city by ordinance
 4-14 or resolution consents to the addition.

4-15 Sec. 3796.0307. DISBURSEMENTS AND TRANSFERS OF MONEY. The
 4-16 board by resolution shall establish the number of directors'
 4-17 signatures and the procedure required for a disbursement or
 4-18 transfer of district money.

4-19 Sec. 3796.0308. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district may
 4-20 be divided into two or more new districts only if the district:

4-21 (1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and

4-22 (2) is not imposing ad valorem taxes.

4-23 (b) This chapter applies to any new district created by the
 4-24 division of the district, and a new district has all the powers and
 4-25 duties of the district.

4-26 (c) Any new district created by the division of the district
 4-27 may not, at the time the new district is created, contain any land
 4-28 outside the area described by Section 2 of the Act enacting this
 4-29 chapter.

4-30 (d) The board, on its own motion or on receipt of a petition
 4-31 signed by the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed value of
 4-32 the real property in the district, may adopt an order dividing the
 4-33 district.

4-34 (e) An order dividing the district must:

4-35 (1) name each new district;

4-36 (2) include the metes and bounds description of the
 4-37 territory of each new district;

4-38 (3) appoint initial directors for each new district;
 4-39 and

4-40 (4) provide for the division of assets and liabilities
 4-41 between or among the new districts.

4-42 (f) On or before the 30th day after the date of adoption of
 4-43 an order dividing the district, the district shall file the order
 4-44 with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and record the
 4-45 order in the real property records of each county in which the
 4-46 district is located.

4-47 (g) Municipal consent to the creation of the district and to
 4-48 the inclusion of land in the district granted under Section
 4-49 3796.0503 acts as municipal consent to the creation of any new
 4-50 district created by the division of the district and to the
 4-51 inclusion of land in the new district.

4-52 Sec. 3796.0309. CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY NOT EXEMPT.
 4-53 Section 375.161, Local Government Code, does not apply to the
 4-54 district.

4-55 Sec. 3796.0310. NO AD VALOREM TAX. The district may not
 4-56 impose an ad valorem tax.

4-57 Sec. 3796.0311. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may
 4-58 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

4-59 SUBCHAPTER D. ASSESSMENTS

4-60 Sec. 3796.0401. PETITION REQUIRED FOR FINANCING SERVICES
 4-61 AND IMPROVEMENTS WITH ASSESSMENTS. (a) The board may not finance a
 4-62 service or improvement project with assessments under this chapter
 4-63 unless a written petition requesting that service or improvement
 4-64 has been filed with the board.

4-65 (b) A petition filed under Subsection (a) must be signed by
 4-66 the owners of a majority of the assessed value of real property in
 4-67 the district subject to assessment according to the most recent
 4-68 certified tax appraisal roll for the county.

4-69 Sec. 3796.0402. ASSESSMENTS; LIENS FOR ASSESSMENTS. (a)

5-1 The board by resolution may impose and collect an assessment for any
 5-2 purpose authorized by this chapter in all or any part of the
 5-3 district.

5-4 (b) An assessment, a reassessment, or an assessment
 5-5 resulting from an addition to or correction of the assessment roll
 5-6 by the district, penalties and interest on an assessment or
 5-7 reassessment, an expense of collection, and reasonable attorney's
 5-8 fees incurred by the district:

5-9 (1) are a first and prior lien against the property
 5-10 assessed;

5-11 (2) are superior to any other lien or claim other than
 5-12 a lien or claim for county, school district, or municipal ad valorem
 5-13 taxes; and

5-14 (3) are the personal liability of and a charge against
 5-15 the owners of the property even if the owners are not named in the
 5-16 assessment proceedings.

5-17 (c) The lien is effective from the date of the board's
 5-18 resolution imposing the assessment until the date the assessment is
 5-19 paid. The board may enforce the lien in the same manner that a
 5-20 taxing unit, as that term is defined by Section 1.04, Tax Code, may
 5-21 enforce an ad valorem tax lien against real property.

5-22 (d) The board may make a correction to or deletion from the
 5-23 assessment roll that does not increase the amount of assessment of
 5-24 any parcel of land without providing notice and holding a hearing in
 5-25 the manner required for additional assessments.

5-26 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS

5-27 Sec. 3796.0501. AUTHORITY TO BORROW MONEY AND TO ISSUE
 5-28 BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS. (a) The district may borrow money on
 5-29 terms determined by the board.

5-30 (b) The district may issue, by public or private sale,
 5-31 bonds, notes, or other obligations payable wholly or partly from
 5-32 assessments, revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district
 5-33 money, or any combination of those sources of money, to pay for any
 5-34 authorized district purpose.

5-35 (c) The district may issue, by public or private sale,
 5-36 bonds, notes, or other obligations payable wholly or partly from
 5-37 assessments in the manner provided by Subchapter A, Chapter 372,
 5-38 Local Government Code, if the improvement financed by the
 5-39 obligation issued under this section will be conveyed to or
 5-40 operated and maintained by a municipality or other retail utility
 5-41 provider pursuant to an agreement with the district entered into
 5-42 before the issuance of the obligation.

5-43 Sec. 3796.0502. BONDS SECURED BY REVENUE OR CONTRACT
 5-44 PAYMENTS. The district may issue, without an election, bonds
 5-45 secured by:

5-46 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes, including
 5-47 contract revenues; or

5-48 (2) contract payments, provided that the requirements
 5-49 of Section 49.108, Water Code, have been met.

5-50 Sec. 3796.0503. CONSENT OF CITY REQUIRED. The board may not
 5-51 issue bonds until the city has consented by ordinance or resolution
 5-52 to the creation of the district and to the inclusion of land in the
 5-53 district.

5-54 SUBCHAPTER I. DISSOLUTION

5-55 Sec. 3796.0901. DISSOLUTION. (a) The board shall dissolve
 5-56 the district on written petition filed with the board by the owners
 5-57 of:

5-58 (1) a simple majority of the assessed value subject to
 5-59 assessment by the district of the property in the district based on
 5-60 the most recent certified county property tax rolls; or

5-61 (2) a simple majority of the surface area of the
 5-62 district, excluding roads, streets, highways, utility
 5-63 rights-of-way, other public areas, and other property exempt from
 5-64 assessment by the district according to the most recent certified
 5-65 county property tax rolls.

5-66 (b) The district may not be dissolved if the district:

5-67 (1) has any outstanding bonded or other indebtedness
 5-68 until that bonded or other indebtedness has been repaid or defeased
 5-69 in accordance with the order or resolution authorizing the issuance

6-1 of the bonded or other indebtedness;
 6-2 (2) has a contractual obligation to pay money until
 6-3 that obligation has been fully paid in accordance with the
 6-4 contract; or

6-5 (3) owns, operates, or maintains public works,
 6-6 facilities, or improvements unless the district has contracted with
 6-7 another party for the ownership and operation or maintenance of the
 6-8 public works, facilities, or improvements.

6-9 (c) Section 375.262, Local Government Code, does not apply
 6-10 to the district.

6-11 SECTION 2. The Honey Creek Improvement District No. 1
 6-12 initially includes all territory contained in the following area:

 20-43 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
 20-44 Government Code.

20-45 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
 20-46 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
 20-47 Environmental Quality.

20-48 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
 20-49 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor,
 20-50 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives
 20-51 within the required time.

20-52 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
 20-53 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
 20-54 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act have been
 20-55 fulfilled and accomplished.

20-56 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 20-57 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 20-58 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 20-59 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 20-60 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
