A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the Open R Fresh Water Supply District of Caldwell County; granting a limited power of eminent domain; providing 3 authority to issue bonds; providing authority to 4 impose 5 assessments, fees, and taxes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws 7 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 7994A to read as follows: 8 9 CHAPTER 7994A. OPEN R FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT OF CALDWELL 10 COUNTY 11 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS 12 Sec. 7994A.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: (1) "Board" means the district's board of directors. 13 14 (2) "Director" means a board member. (3) "District" means the Open R Fresh Water Supply 15 16 District of Caldwell County. Sec. 7994A.0102. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a 17 municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI, 18 Texas Constitution. 19 Sec. 7994A.0103. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT. 20 21 (a) The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit. (b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of: 22 23 (1) a municipal utility district as provided by 24 general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and

2	relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation,
3	or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or
4	improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.
5	Sec. 7994A.0104. DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The district is
6	composed of the territory described by Section 2 of the Act enacting
7	this chapter.
8	(b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
9	the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
10	field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
11	does not affect the district's:
12	(1) organization, existence, or validity;

Sec. 7994A.0302. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) 8 If authorized at an election held under Section 7994A.0301, the 9 10 district may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water 11 12 Code. 13 (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not 14 exceed the rate approved at the election. 15 Sec. 7994A.0303. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than 16 17 an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of 18 19 the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters voting at an election held for that purpose. 20 21 (b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a 22 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by 23 the board without further voter approval. 24 SUBCHAPTER D. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS Sec. 7994A.0401. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER 25 26 OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees, 27

1 revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any 2 combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district 3 purpose.

<u>Sec. 7994A.0402. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district</u> <u>issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the</u> <u>board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing</u> <u>direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all</u> <u>or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner</u> <u>provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.</u>

10 <u>Sec. 7994A.0403. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of</u> 11 <u>issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations</u> 12 <u>issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad</u> 13 <u>valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the</u> 14 <u>real property in the district.</u>

26 SECTION 3. (a) All governmental and proprietary actions 27 and proceedings of the Open R Fresh Water Supply District of

Caldwell County taken before the effective date of this Act are
 validated, ratified, and confirmed in all respects as of the dates
 on which they occurred.

4 (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the5 effective date of this Act:

6 (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation 7 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final court 8 judgment; or

9 (2) has been held invalid by a final court judgment. SECTION 4. (a) 10 The legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 11 12 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 13 14 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 15 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, Government Code. 16

17 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has 18 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on 19 Environmental Quality.

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 20 (C) its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 21 22 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of 23 representatives within the required time.

(d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
and accomplished.

1 SECTION 5. (a) If this Act does not receive a two-thirds 2 vote of all the members elected to each house, Subchapter B, Chapter 3 7994A, Special District Local Laws Code, as added by Section 1 of 4 this Act, is amended by adding Section 7994A.0205 to read as 5 follows:

6 <u>Sec. 7994A.0205.</u> NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may 7 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

8 (b) This section is not intended to be an expression of a 9 legislative interpretation of the requirements of Section 17(c), 10 Article I, Texas Constitution.

SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
