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#### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the creation of the Highland Park Municipal Utility District of Grayson County; granting a limited power of eminent 3 domain; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to 4 5 impose assessments, fees, and taxes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws 7 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8000A to read as follows: 8 9 CHAPTER 8000A. HIGHLAND PARK MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT OF GRAYSON 10 COUNTY 11 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS 12 Sec. 8000A.0101. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: "Board" means the district's board of directors. 13 (1) (2) "Commission" means the <u>Texas</u> Commission on 14 15 Environmental Quality. 16 (3) "Director" means a board member. (4) "District" means the Highland Park Municipal 17 Util<u>ity District of Grayson County.</u> 18 Sec. 8000A.0102. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a 19 municipal utility district created under Section 59, Article XVI, 20 21 Texas Constitution. Sec. 8000A.0103. CONFIRMATION AND DIRECTOR ELECTION 22 23 REQUIRED. The temporary directors shall hold an election to confirm the creation of the district and to elect five permanent 24

1	directors as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.
2	Sec. 8000A.0104. CONSENT OF MUNICIPALITY REQUIRED. The
3	temporary directors may not hold an election under Section
4	8000A.0103 until each municipality in whose corporate limits or
5	extraterritorial jurisdiction the district is located has
6	consented by ordinance or resolution to the creation of the
7	district and to the inclusion of land in the district as required by
8	applicable law.
9	Sec. 8000A.0105. FINDINGS OF PUBLIC PURPOSE AND BENEFIT.
10	(a) The district is created to serve a public purpose and benefit.
11	(b) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of:
12	(1) a municipal utility district as provided by
13	general law and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution; and
14	(2) Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, that
15	relate to the construction, acquisition, improvement, operation,
16	or maintenance of macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or
17	improvements, including storm drainage, in aid of those roads.
18	Sec. 8000A.0106. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
19	district is initially composed of the territory described by
20	Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.
21	(b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
22	the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
23	field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
24	does not affect the district's:
25	(1) organization, existence, or validity;
26	(2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes
27	for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and

1	interest on a bond;
2	(3) right to impose a tax; or
3	(4) legality or operation.
4	SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS
5	Sec. 8000A.0201. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district
6	is governed by a board of five elected directors.
7	(b) Except as provided by Section 8000A.0202, directors
8	serve staggered four-year terms.
9	Sec. 8000A.0202. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after
10	September 1, 2023, the owner or owners of a majority of the assessed
11	value of the real property in the district may submit a petition to
12	the commission requesting that the commission appoint as temporary
13	directors the five persons named in the petition. The commission
14	shall appoint as temporary directors the five persons named in the
15	petition.
16	(b) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:
17	(1) the date permanent directors are elected under
18	Section 8000A.0103; or
19	(2) September 1, 2027.
20	(c) If permanent directors have not been elected under
21	Section 8000A.0103 and the terms of the temporary directors have
22	expired, successor temporary directors shall be appointed or
23	reappointed as provided by Subsection (d) to serve terms that
24	expire on the earlier of:
25	(1) the date permanent directors are elected under
26	Section 8000A.0103; or
27	(2) the fourth anniversary of the date of the

1 appointment or reappointment. 2 (d) If Subsection (c) applies, the owner or owners of a 3 majority of the assessed value of the real property in the district may submit a petition to the commission requesting that the 4 5 commission appoint as successor temporary directors the five persons named in the petition. The commission shall appoint as 6 7 successor temporary directors the five persons named in the 8 petition. 9 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES Sec. 8000A.0301. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district 10 has the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for 11 12 which the district is created. Sec. 8000A.0302. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND 13 14 DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided by the 15 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59, 16 17 Article XVI, Texas Constitution. Sec. 8000A.0303. AUTHORITY FOR ROAD PROJECTS. 18 Under Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may 19 design, acquire, construct, finance, issue bonds for, improve, 20 operate, maintain, and convey to this state, a county, or a 21 22 municipality for operation and maintenance macadamized, graveled, or paved roads, or improvements, including storm drainage, in aid 23 24 of those roads. Sec. 8000A.0304. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A 25 26 road project must meet all applicable construction standards, zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations of each 27

1	municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial
2	jurisdiction the road project is located.
3	(b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits
4	or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road
5	project must meet all applicable construction standards,
6	subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which
7	the road project is located.
8	(c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the
9	Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and
10	specifications of the road project.
11	Sec. 8000A.0305. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT
12	ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION. The district shall comply with all
13	applicable requirements of any ordinance or resolution that is
14	adopted under Section 54.016 or 54.0165, Water Code, and that
15	consents to the creation of the district or to the inclusion of land
16	in the district.
17	Sec. 8000A.0306. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The board, on
18	its own motion or on receipt of a petition signed by the owner or
19	owners of a majority of the assessed value of the real property in
20	the district, may adopt an order dividing the district.
21	(b) An order dividing a district may create one or more new
22	districts and may provide for the continuation of the district.
23	(c) An order dividing the district shall:
24	(1) name any new district;
25	(2) include the metes and bounds description of the
26	territory of each of the districts;
27	(3) appoint temporary directors for any new district;

1 and 2 (4) provide for the division of assets and liabilities 3 between the districts. 4 (d) The board may adopt an order dividing the district 5 before or after the date the board holds an election to confirm the district's creation. 6 7 (e) The district may be divided only if the district: 8 (1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and 9 (2) is not imposing ad valorem taxes. (f) A new district created by the division of the district 10 may not, at the time the new district is created, contain any land 11 12 outside the area described by Section 2 of the Act enacting this 13 chapter. (g) On or before the 30th day after the date of adoption of 14 15 an order dividing the district, the district shall file the order with the commission and record the order in the real property 16 17 records of each county in which the district is located. (h) This chapter applies to any new district created by the 18 19 division of the district, and a new district has all the powers and duties of the district. 20 21 (i) A new district created by the division of the district shall hold a confirmation and directors' election. 22 (j) If the creation of the new district is confirmed, the 23 24 new district shall provide the election date and results to the commission. 25 26 (k) A new district created by the division of the district must hold an election as required by this chapter to obtain voter 27

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1 approval before the district may impose a maintenance tax or issue 2 bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes. (1) The district may continue to rely on confirmation, 3 directors', bond, or tax elections held prior to the division. 4 5 (m) Municipal consent to the creation of the district and to the inclusion of land in the district acts as municipal consent to 6 7 the creation of any new district created by the division of the 8 district and to the inclusion of land in the new district. SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS 9 Sec. 8000A.0401. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a) 10 The district may issue, without an election, bonds and other 11 12 obligations secured by: 13 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or 14 (2) contract payments described by Section 15 8000A.0403. (b) The district must hold an election in the manner 16 provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval 17 before the district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds 18 19 payable from ad valorem taxes. (c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem 20 taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a 21 22 vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an 23 election held for that purpose. 24 Sec. 8000A.0402. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) Ιf authorized at an election held under Section 8000A.0401, the 25 26 district may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water 27

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1 <u>Code</u>.

2 (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
3 exceed the rate approved at the election.

Sec. 8000A.0403. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters voting at an election held for that purpose.

10 (b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a 11 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by 12 the board without further voter approval.

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SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS

14 <u>Sec. 8000A.0501. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER</u> 15 <u>OBLIGATIONS. The district may issue bonds or other obligations</u> 16 <u>payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,</u> 17 <u>revenue, contract payments, grants, or other district money, or any</u> 18 <u>combination of those sources, to pay for any authorized district</u> 19 <u>purpose.</u>

20 <u>Sec. 8000A.0502. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district</u> 21 <u>issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the</u> 22 <u>board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing</u> 23 <u>direct ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, while all</u> 24 <u>or part of the bonds are outstanding as required and in the manner</u> 25 <u>provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602, Water Code.</u>

26 <u>Sec. 8000A.0503.</u> BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of 27 issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations

issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad
 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the

3 real property in the district.

4 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to 5 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 6 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 7 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 8 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 9 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 10 Government Code.

(b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
