A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to provide cost-of-living adjustments or other benefit
- 3 enhancements to eligible annuitants of the Teacher Retirement
- 4 System of Texas and providing a one-time transfer of funds for
- 5 contributions, actuarially determined payments, and benefit
- 6 enhancements.
- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 9 adding Section 67-a to read as follows:
- Sec. 67-a. (a) Only as authorized by this section, the
- 11 legislature by general law may provide one or more cost-of-living
- 12 <u>adjustments or supplemental payments as benefit enhancements to</u>
- 13 annuitants of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas who are
- 14 eligible for the enhancements, as determined by that law.
- 15 (b) The legislature may provide a benefit enhancement as
- 16 described by this section and direct the comptroller of public
- 17 accounts to transfer funds to the Teacher Retirement System of
- 18 Texas for the payment of the benefit enhancement only if:
- 19 (1) the retirement system is actuarially sound, as
- 20 determined by general law; and
- 21 (2) the legislature appropriates money in an amount
- 22 sufficient to fully pay for the benefit enhancement, as determined
- 23 by the board of trustees of the retirement system.
- 24 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to

- 1 the Texas Constitution:
- 2 <u>TEMPORARY PROVISION</u>. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 3 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 88th Legislature,
- 4 Regular Session, 2023, authorizing the legislature to provide
- 5 cost-of-living adjustments or other benefit enhancements to
- 6 eligible annuitants of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas and
- 7 providing a one-time transfer of funds for contributions,
- 8 actuarially determined payments, and benefit enhancements.
- 9 (b) As soon as practicable after the effective date of the
- 10 amendment to which this temporary provision applies, the
- 11 comptroller of public accounts shall transfer \$3.45 billion from
- 12 the general revenue fund to the trust fund of the Teacher Retirement
- 13 System of Texas. Money transferred to the trust fund under this
- 14 temporary provision may be spent by the system only for the purposes
- 15 of providing contributions, actuarially determined payments, and
- 16 benefit enhancements to the system's annuitants, as provided by
- 17 general law. The transfer made under this temporary provision is
- 18 not an appropriation of state tax revenues for the purposes of
- 19 Section 22, Article VIII, of this constitution.
- 20 (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2056.
- 21 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 22 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 23 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 24 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 25 legislature to provide cost-of-living adjustments or other benefit
- 26 enhancements to eligible annuitants of the Teacher Retirement
- 27 System of Texas and providing a one-time transfer of \$3.45 billion
