## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to provide one-time or ongoing benefit enhancements to eligible
- 3 annuitants of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas, including a
- 4 one-time transfer of funds for that purpose.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 51-h to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51-h. (a) The legislature by general law may provide
- 9 for a one-time or ongoing benefit enhancement to eligible
- 10 <u>annuitants of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas only as</u>
- 11 authorized by this section.
- 12 (b) The legislature may enact a general law to provide a
- 13 one-time or ongoing benefit enhancement as described in Subsection
- 14 (a) and direct the comptroller of public accounts to transfer funds
- 15 to the Teacher Retirement System of Texas for the payment of any
- 16 benefit enhancement only if the retirement system is actuarially
- 17 sound as defined by general law.
- 18 <u>(c) The legislature may not provide a one-time or ongoing</u>
- 19 benefit enhancement to eligible annuitants of the Teacher
- 20 Retirement of Texas without an accompanying appropriation of funds
- 21 that is sufficient to fully pay for the benefit enhancement, as
- 22 determined by the retirement system.
- 23 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 24 the Texas Constitution:

- 1 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 2 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 88th Legislature,
- 3 Regular Session, 2023, adding Section 51-h to Article III of this
- 4 constitution.
- 5 (b) As soon as practicable after the effective date of the
- 6 amendment adding Section 51-h to Article III of this constitution,
- 7 the comptroller of public accounts shall transfer from the general
- 8 revenue fund the amount of \$3.45 billion to the Teacher Retirement
- 9 System of Texas for the two-year period beginning September 1, 2023
- 10 for the purpose of providing one-time contributions, legacy
- 11 payments, and benefit enhancements to the system's annuitants as
- 12 provided by the enabling legislation enacted in anticipation of the
- 13 adoption of the proposed constitutional amendment and only if the
- 14 <u>amortization period of the system's unfunded actuarial liabilities</u>
- 15 complies with any period prescribed by law, including any enabling
- 16 <u>legislation</u>. The transfer made under this temporary provision is
- 17 not an appropriation of state tax revenues for the purposes of
- 18 Section 22, Article VIII, of this constitution.
- 19 (c) The funds described in Subsection (b) are deemed
- 20 available to the system as of September 1, 2023, regardless of the
- 21 date the comptroller actually transfers the funds to the system.
- 22 <u>(d) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2025.</u>
- 23 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 24 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 25 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 26 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 27 legislature to provide one-time or ongoing benefit enhancements to

- 1 eligible annuitants of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas,
- 2 including a one-time transfer of \$3.45 billion to the retirement
- 3 system for that purpose."
