A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to enact laws providing for a court to terminate the sentence of a
- 3 person who has successfully served the required number of years on
- 4 parole.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 11(a), Article IV, Texas Constitution,
- 7 is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The Legislature shall by law establish a Board of
- 9 Pardons and Paroles and shall require it to keep record of its
- 10 actions and the reasons for its actions. The Legislature shall have
- 11 authority to enact parole laws, including laws authorizing a court
- 12 to terminate the sentence of a person who has successfully served
- 13 the specified number of years on parole required by law, and laws
- 14 that require or permit courts to inform juries about the effect of
- 15 good conduct time and eligibility for parole or mandatory
- 16 supervision on the period of incarceration served by a defendant
- 17 convicted of a criminal offense.
- 18 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 19 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 20 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 21 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 22 legislature to enact laws providing for a court to terminate the
- 23 sentence of a person who has successfully served the required
- 24 number of years on parole."
