A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to dedicate net state lottery
- 2 revenue to support educational programs that benefit classroom
- 3 teaching in public schools and to prohibit advertisements and

- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 47, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 8 amended by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (f) to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (e) The Legislature by general law may authorize the State
- 11 to operate lotteries and may authorize the State to enter into a
- 12 contract with one or more legal entities that will operate
- 13 lotteries on behalf of the State. All money the State receives from
- 14 the operation of lotteries, other than amounts paid for
- 15 administrative costs, lottery prizes, and unclaimed lottery
- 16 prizes, is dedicated to and may be expended only for the enrichment
- 17 of educational programs in the State's public primary and secondary
- 18 schools that directly benefit classroom teaching, including
- 19 <u>teacher compensation and the acquisition of educational materials</u>
- 20 <u>and services.</u>
- 21 (f) The State, a state agency or political subdivision of
- 22 the State, a legal entity contracting to operate lotteries
- 23 <u>authorized by Subsection (e) of this section, or a holder of a</u>
- 24 license issued by the State related to the operation of a lottery

- 1 authorized by that subsection may not sponsor an advertisement or
- 2 promotion that encourages or attempts to influence a person to
- 3 purchase a lottery ticket by stating or implying the revenue
- 4 generated from the ticket sale will financially assist the State's
- 5 public primary or secondary schools.
- 6 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 7 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 8 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 9 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to dedicate net state
- 10 lottery revenue to support educational programs that benefit
- 11 classroom teaching in public schools and to prohibit advertisements
- 12 and promotions that state or imply lottery ticket sales revenue
- 13 will financially assist public schools."
