A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation income-producing tangible 3 personal property having a value of less than a certain amount.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 1(g), Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
6 is amended to read as follows:

7 (g) The Legislature <u>by general law</u> may exempt from ad 8 valorem taxation tangible personal property that is held or used 9 for the production of income and <u>that</u> has a taxable value of less 10 than <u>\$100,000</u> [the minimum amount sufficient to recover the costs 11 of the administration of the taxes on the property, as determined by 12 or under the general law granting the exemption].

13 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023. 15 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the 17 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation income-producing 18 tangible personal property having a value of less than \$100,000."
