A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the creation of
- 2 the land and water conservation fund, dedicating certain money in
- 3 that fund to the conservation of, restoration of, or public access
- 4 to land, water, or natural resources in this state, and providing
- 5 for the transfer of certain general revenues to the economic
- 6 stabilization fund, the land and water conservation fund, and the
- 7 state highway fund.
- 8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 9 SECTION 1. Sections 49-g(c) and (c-1), Article III, Texas 10 Constitution, are amended to read as follows:
- 11 (c) Not later than the 90th day of each fiscal year, the
- 12 comptroller of public accounts shall transfer from the general
- 13 revenue fund to the economic stabilization fund, the land and water
- 14 conservation fund, and the state highway fund the sum of the amounts
- 15 described by Subsections (d) and (e) of this section, to be
- 16 allocated as provided by Subsections (c-1) and (c-2) of this
- 17 section. However, if necessary and notwithstanding the
- 18 allocations prescribed by Subsections (c-1) and (c-2) of this
- 19 section, the comptroller shall reduce proportionately the amounts
- 20 described by Subsections (d) and (e) of this section to be
- 21 transferred and allocated to the economic stabilization fund to
- 22 prevent the amount in that fund from exceeding the limit in effect
- 23 for that biennium under Subsection (g) of this section. Revenue
- 24 transferred to the state highway fund under this subsection may be

- 1 used only for constructing, maintaining, and acquiring
- 2 rights-of-way for public roadways other than toll roads.
- 3 (c-1) Except as provided by Subsection (c-2) of this
- 4 section, the comptroller shall allocate [Of] the sum of the amounts
- 5 described by Subsections (d) and (e) of this section and required to
- 6 be transferred from the general revenue fund under Subsection (c)
- 7 of this section as follows:
- 8 (1) 46 percent of that sum [, the comptroller shall
- 9 allocate one-half] to the economic stabilization fund;
- 10 (2) four percent of that sum to the land and water
- 11 conservation fund; and
- 12 (3) the remainder of that sum to the state highway fund
- 13 [rexcept as provided by Subsection (c-2) of this section].
- 14 SECTION 2. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 15 adding Section 49-g-1 to read as follows:
- Sec. 49-g-1. (a) The land and water conservation fund is
- 17 established as a special fund in the state treasury.
- 18 (b) The land and water conservation fund consists of money
- 19 transferred to the fund under Section 49-g of this article and money
- 20 the legislature:
- 21 (1) may appropriate to the credit of the fund; or
- 22 (2) by general law may dedicate or provide for deposit
- 23 to the credit of the fund.
- (c) Money in the land and water conservation fund may be
- 25 spent:
- 26 <u>(1) without further appropriation;</u>
- 27 (2) only for purposes related to the conservation of,

- 1 restoration of, or public access to land, water, or natural
- 2 resources in this state; and
- 3 (3) without further legislative appropriation.
- 4 SECTION 3. The following temporary provision is added to
- 5 the Texas Constitution:
- 6 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 7 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 88th Legislature,
- 8 Regular Session, 2023, providing for the creation of the land and
- 9 water conservation fund, dedicating certain money in that fund to
- 10 the conservation of, restoration of, or public access to land,
- 11 water, or natural resources in this state, and providing for the
- 12 transfer of certain general revenues to the economic stabilization
- 13 fund, the land and water conservation fund, and the state highway
- 14 fund.
- 15 (b) The transfers and allocations to be made under Sections
- 16 49-g(c) and (c-1), Article III, of this constitution are to be made
- 17 beginning with the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 2025.
- 18 (c) This temporary provision expires September 1, 2026.
- 19 SECTION 4. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 20 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 21 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 22 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
- 23 creation of the land and water conservation fund, dedicating
- 24 certain money in that fund to the conservation of, restoration of,
- 25 or public access to land, water, or natural resources in this state,
- 26 and providing for the transfer of certain general revenues to the
- 27 economic stabilization fund, the land and water conservation fund,

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1 and the state highway fund."
