A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature
- 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation the portion of the assessed value
- 3 of a person's property that is attributable to the installation or
- 4 construction in or on the property of border security
- 5 infrastructure.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 1-s to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 1-s. The legislature by general law may exempt from ad
- 10 valorem taxation the portion of the assessed value of a person's
- 11 property that is attributable to the installation or construction
- 12 in or on the property of border security infrastructure and may
- 13 provide additional eligibility requirements for the exemption.
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize the
- 18 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation the portion of the
- 19 assessed value of a person's property that is attributable to the
- 20 installation or construction in or on the property of border
- 21 security infrastructure."
