A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation income-producing tangible
- 3 personal property having a value of less than a certain amount.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1(g), Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (g) The Legislature by general law may exempt from ad
- 8 valorem taxation tangible personal property that is held or used
- 9 for the production of income and $\underline{\text{that}}$ has a taxable value of less
- 10 than an amount specified [the minimum amount sufficient to recover
- 11 the costs of the administration of the taxes on the property, as
- 12 determined] by the Legislature in [or under] the general law
- 13 granting the exemption.
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 18 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation income-producing
- 19 tangible personal property having a value of less than a certain
- 20 amount."
