A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation a mineral interest that has a 3 value of less than a certain amount.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 1(h), Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
6 is amended to read as follows:

7 (h) The Legislature <u>by general law</u> may exempt from ad 8 valorem taxation a mineral interest that has a taxable value of less 9 than <u>an amount specified</u> [the minimum amount sufficient to recover 10 the costs of the administration of the taxes on the interest, as 11 determined] by the Legislature in [or under] the general law 12 granting the exemption.

13 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023. 15 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the 17 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation a mineral interest 18 that has a value of less than a certain amount."
