## A JOINT RESOLUTION

proposing a constitutional amendment allowing recovery of
exemplary damages by parents or a person's estate for a homicide.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 26, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is 5 amended to read as follows:

6 Sec. 26. Every person, corporation, or company, that may 7 commit a homicide, through wilful act, or omission, or gross 8 neglect, shall be responsible, in exemplary damages, to the 9 surviving <u>spouse</u>, <u>children</u>, <u>or parents</u> [<u>husband</u>, <u>widow</u>, <u>heirs of</u> 10 <u>his or her body</u>], [<del>or</del>] such of them as there may be, <u>or the deceased</u> 11 <u>person's estate</u> without regard to any criminal proceeding that may 12 or may not be had in relation to the homicide.

13 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023. 15 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment allowing recovery of 17 exemplary damages by parents or a person's estate for a homicide."
