R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Wesley Hunt of Houston has been elected to the  
2 United States House of Representatives, and he was officially sworn  
3 into office on January 7, 2023; and

4 WHEREAS, Wesley Hunt represents the newly created 38th  
5 Congressional District, which covers parts of Houston and Harris  
6 County, including much of the Katy Freeway corridor west of  
7 downtown Houston and the Houston suburbs of Jersey Village,  
8 Cypress, Tomball, Katy, and Klein; and

9 WHEREAS, A native of Houston, Congressman Hunt grew up in a  
10 military family and is a proud alumnus of St. John's School;  
11 following his graduation, he accepted an appointment to the United  
12 States Military Academy at West Point; in 2004, he received his  
13 commission in the U.S. Army and graduated from West Point,  
14 receiving a bachelor's degree in leadership and management with a  
15 field of study in mechanical engineering; he subsequently spent  
16 eight years in the army as an aviation branch officer and an AH-64D  
17 Apache Longbow helicopter pilot; and

18 WHEREAS, Representative Hunt's military service included a  
19 combat deployment to Iraq and two deployments to Saudi Arabia,  
20 where he served as a diplomatic liaison officer; in that role, he  
21 represented the U.S. government in missions involving the Royal  
22 Saudi Land Forces Aviation Command; following his honorable  
23 discharge at the rank of captain, he earned master's degrees in  
24 business administration, public administration, and industrial and

1 labor relations from Cornell University; and

2 WHEREAS, Actively involved with many organizations in the  
3 Houston area, Congressman Hunt is a dedicated volunteer and serves  
4 on the board of trustees at St. John's School; moreover, he has  
5 mentored youth at the MacCormick Juvenile Detention Center and at  
6 Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Texas in Austin; he and his  
7 wife, Emily, are the devoted parents of two daughters, Victoria and  
8 Olivia; and

9 WHEREAS, Wesley Hunt has demonstrated a longstanding  
10 commitment to serving his country and his community, and his  
11 leadership will be integral to the important work carried out by the  
12 U.S. Congress in the years ahead; now, therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas  
14 Legislature hereby congratulate the Honorable Wesley Hunt on his  
15 election to the U.S. House of Representatives and extend to him  
16 sincere best wishes for a successful term in office; and, be it
