1 WHEREAS, Principal Amy McAfee of Crandall Middle School won  
2 distinction for herself and her campus with her selection to attend  
3 a summer institute at The Principals' Center at the Harvard  
4 Graduate School of Education in 2022; and

5 WHEREAS, Established in 1981, The Principals' Center offers  
6 professional development programs to school leaders from around the  
7 world; its summer institute allows participants the opportunity to  
8 take part in a weeklong workshop on leadership development led by  
9 Harvard faculty members and other national and international  
10 experts; attendees from Texas are selected by the Charles Butt  
11 Foundation through its Raising School Leaders program, which covers  
12 all expenses for the summer institute, including travel, lodging,  
13 and tuition; Ms. McAfee was one of 85 educators from across the Lone  
14 Star State to attend the 2022 institute; and

15 WHEREAS, Amy McAfee has been an educator for nearly three  
16 decades, and she is entering her 10th year as principal of Crandall  
17 Middle School; she previously worked for the Mabank Independent  
18 School District as a teacher, an instructional coach, a counselor,  
19 and an elementary and middle school assistant principal; she holds  
20 a bachelor's degree in interdisciplinary studies and a master's  
21 degree in education from Texas A&M University-Commerce, as well as  
22 certifications in school counseling and administration; and

23 WHEREAS, Through her skill, dedication, and professionalism,  
24 Amy McAfee is helping to provide a strong academic foundation for

1 the students of Crandall Middle School, and her selection for this  
2 prestigious program represents a significant milestone in her  
3 career; now, therefore, be it
