1 WHEREAS, Representatives of the Texas Ports Association are 2 gathering in Austin for Texas Ports Day at the State Capitol on 3 February 21, 2023; and

WHEREAS, An essential element of the state's economy, which 4 5 is the ninth-largest economy in the world, Texas ports play an integral role in the international supply chain; the system boasts 6 7 the largest container port on the Gulf Coast, the largest breakbulk gateway in the U.S., the leading energy export gateway in the 8 9 nation, and the largest port in the country in total revenue tonnage; ranked second in the U.S. in waterborne commerce, Texas 10 11 ports handle 616.2 million tons of foreign and domestic cargo, 12 generate \$449.6 billion of total economic value for the state, and impact more than 1.8 million jobs; a recent Global Trade article 13 14 lauded the state with the greatest cluster of power ports among the top 20 list; moreover, three Texas ports are designated as 15 16 strategic military ports by the U.S. Department of Defense, providing surface deployment and worldwide distribution for 17 military cargo; and 18

WHEREAS, The Texas Ports Association is an alliance of more 19 than 20 maritime ports along the Gulf Coast, and it represents a 20 21 number of import and export industries; the organization advocates 22 infrastructure projects that will help for supply chain 23 constraints, enhance port efficiency, improve the movement of freight through intermodal systems, create new jobs, and attract 24
