- 4 WHEREAS, Founded as San Angelo Junior College, ASU opened its
- 5 doors in 1928 with an initial enrollment of 112 students, and its
- 6 first graduating class consisted of six students; in the 1930s, the
- 7 school changed its name to San Angelo College, and it evolved into a
- 8 four-year, state-supported university during the 1960s; the school
- 9 adopted the name Angelo State College in 1965 and Angelo State
- 10 University in 1969; it was part of the Texas State University System
- 11 from 1963 to 2007, when it joined the Texas Tech University System;

- WHEREAS, Today, ASU serves more than 10,500 students and
- 14 employs some 900 faculty and staff members, who benefit from the
- 15 able leadership of President Ronnie D. Hawkins Jr.; it offers a wide
- 16 range of undergraduate and graduate programs with more than 100
- 17 majors and concentrations, including an essential and rapidly
- 18 expanding commercial aviation program, across its six colleges,
- 19 which encompass health and human services, arts and humanities,
- 20 education, science and engineering, business, and graduate studies
- 21 and research; in addition, the school established the ASU
- 22 Distinguished Scholarship Program, which is funded by one of the
- 23 largest endowments at a U.S. regional university; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Among its many achievements, ASU has been ranked as

- 1 one of the nation's best colleges by The Princeton Review every year
- 2 since 2010; it has also been named a Hispanic-Serving Institution
- 3 by the U.S. Department of Education and a Military Friendly School
- 4 by G.I. Jobs magazine; ASU has more than 49,000 alumni around the
- 5 globe; and
- 6 WHEREAS, For almost nine and a half decades, Angelo State
- 7 University has played an important role in higher education in the
- 8 Lone Star State, and its graduates continue to achieve success and
- 9 make significant contributions in numerous fields of endeavor; now,
- 10 therefore, be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas
- 12 Legislature hereby recognize March 21, 2023, as Angelo State
- 13 University Day at the State Capitol and extend a warm welcome to the
- 14 school's visiting delegation.
