RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, There are nearly 10,000 known diseases and
- 2 conditions that are considered rare by medical authorities in the
- 3 United States, and each year, thousands of Texans are among those
- 4 whose lives are changed by these diseases; and
- 5 WHEREAS, A rare disease is defined as one that affects fewer
- 6 than 200,000 people, but even though a specific disease may afflict
- 7 only a small number of sufferers, such conditions, as a group,
- 8 affect almost 30 million Americans, or nearly one in 10 people in
- 9 our nation; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Many rare diseases are serious and debilitating,
- 11 with a significant impact on the lives of those affected and their
- 12 families, and approximately 95 percent of rare diseases have no
- 13 FDA-approved treatment; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The National Economic Burden of Rare Disease Study
- 15 in the United States estimated that the overall economic burden of
- 16 rare diseases in 2019 exceeded \$966 billion; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Individuals and families who face a rare disease
- 18 often experience a sense of isolation, difficulty in getting an
- 19 accurate and timely diagnosis, few treatment options, and problems
- 20 in receiving reimbursement for treatment; moreover, those who are
- 21 diagnosed with a lesser known disorder often find that they must
- 22 bear the lion's share of the responsibility for raising awareness
- 23 as well as for raising funds for research toward a possible
- 24 treatment or cure; and

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1 WHEREAS, Thousands of patients, family members, friends, co-workers, medical professionals, 2 researchers, officials, and companies developing treatments are pleased to join 3 4 together with patient advocacy organizations like The National Organization for Rare Disorders (NORD), EveryLife Foundation for 5 6 Rare Diseases, and the Texas Rare Alliance as part of a nationwide observance of Rare Disease Day to advocate for continued research 7 8 and access to diagnosis and treatment; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas 9 Legislature hereby recognize February 28, 2023, as Rare Disease Day 10 and encourage all Texans to learn more about this matter of serious 11 12 concern.
