RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, The celebration of The University of Texas at
- 2 Arlington Day at the State Capitol on March 22, 2023, provides a
- 3 fitting occasion to recognize this notable institution; and
- WHEREAS, Founded in 1895 as Arlington College, the school
- 5 initially provided instruction to approximately 75 students from
- 6 the elementary grades through a level roughly equivalent to high
- 7 school; it was converted into Carlisle Military Academy in 1902 and
- 8 was subsequently known as Arlington Training School and then
- 9 Arlington Military Academy; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The institution transitioned into Grubbs Vocational
- 11 College, a branch of the Agricultural and Mechanical College of
- 12 Texas, in 1917; it maintained that affiliation with what is now
- 13 Texas A&M University after changing its name to North Texas
- 14 Agricultural College; by 1949, it was considered the largest
- 15 state-supported junior college in the Southwest, and it was renamed
- 16 Arlington State College; and
- WHEREAS, In 1959, Arlington State became a comprehensive
- 18 four-year institution, and six years later, it joined The
- 19 University of Texas System; the state legislature conferred its
- 20 present-day name in 1967; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The university today is the second largest in the UT
- 22 System; its faculty is especially noted for specialized expertise
- 23 in national defense, information technologies, hypersonics,
- 24 healthcare informatics, energy, bioengineering, and

- 1 biotechnologies; in addition, it awards thousands of degrees each
- 2 year in critical workforce fields such as engineering and science,
- 3 education, and social work, and its nursing program has become the
- 4 largest producer of baccalaureate-prepared registered nurses in
- 5 Texas; and
- 6 WHEREAS, An inclusive and impactful research university, it
- 7 was the state's fourth public university to achieve Texas Tier One
- 8 status in 2021, and it is one of only 21 universities nationwide to
- 9 be categorized as both an R1 institution by the Carnegie
- 10 Classification of Institutions of Higher Education and a
- 11 Hispanic-Serving Institution by the U.S. Department of Education;

- 13 WHEREAS, Over the course of more than 125 years, The
- 14 University of Texas at Arlington has provided its students with a
- 15 strong foundation for achievement, and in so doing, it has played a
- 16 significant role in fostering economic development and enhancing
- 17 the quality of life in the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas
- 19 Legislature hereby recognize March 22, 2023, as The University of
- 20 Texas at Arlington Day at the State Capitol and extend a warm
- 21 welcome to the visiting delegation.
