WHEREAS, Members of the state chapter of Crime Survivors for
Safety and Justice are gathering in Austin on March 30, 2023, for
Survivors Speak Texas Day at the State Capitol; and

WHEREAS, A flagship project of the Alliance for Safety and 4 5 Justice, Crime Survivors for Safety and Justice is a national organization that promotes public safety policies that reduce 6 7 incarceration and increase investments in crime prevention, trauma recovery, and rehabilitation; with chapters in several states 8 9 across the country, the group also provides opportunities for 10 survivors to participate in support groups and community organizing; and 11

WHEREAS, Because more than half of violent crimes are 12 estimated to go unreported, and few survivors receive direct 13 14 assistance from a victim service agency, many people face long-term, debilitating effects without appropriate support; Crime 15 16 Survivors for Safety and Justice helps to bridge these gaps in 17 victim services, as well as to offer guidance to policy makers on evidence-based practices to protect victims and reduce incidents of 18 violent crime; and 19

20 WHEREAS, Each year during National Crime Victims' Rights 21 Week, Crime Survivors for Safety and Justice holds its Survivors 22 Speak event, which brings together crime survivors and their loved 23 ones to advocate for safety and justice policy reforms, 24 particularly in communities with high rates of crime; since its

1 inception, the event has grown into a yearlong movement that 2 culminates in a National Healing Vigil Day of Action, with events in 3 more than two dozen cities around the country; and

WHEREAS, Crime Survivors for Safety and Justice is playing an important role in helping the people and communities most harmed by crime and violence, and all those associated with the organization are indeed deserving of commendation for their tireless advocacy; now, therefore, be it
