- 1 WHEREAS, Residents of Val Verde County and the city of Del Rio
- 2 are gathering in Austin on March 22, 2023, to celebrate Val Verde
- 3 County Day at the State Capitol; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The brushlands along the Rio Grande were first
- 5 inhabited more than 6,000 years ago by native peoples whose cave
- 6 paintings are still visible; the community of San Felipe Del Rio was
- 7 established in 1868, and Val Verde County was organized in 1885;
- 8 that same year, the colorful Judge Roy Bean was elected justice of
- 9 the peace in Langtry, where he became known as "the Law West of the
- 10 Pecos," making his distinctive rulings from the Jersey Lilly
- 11 Saloon; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Since its earliest days, Val Verde County has been a
- 13 center for sheep and goat ranching, and the wool and mohair
- 14 industries continue to be central to its economy; other important
- 15 employers include Laughlin Air Force Base, the U.S. Border Patrol,
- 16 and the National Park Service; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Tourism and trade with Mexico are also part of the
- 18 life of the county; opportunities for boating, fishing, birding,
- 19 and hiking are found at the Amistad National Recreation Area, and
- 20 the Whitehead Memorial Museum in Del Rio and the Judge Roy Bean
- 21 Visitor Center in Langtry attract visitors interested in the
- 22 heritage of the county's frontier days; and
- WHEREAS, Celebrating their rich history as they work to build
- 24 an even brighter future, the people of Val Verde County may take
