## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The observance of Sexual Assault Awareness Month in
April 2023 provides a fitting opportunity to recognize SAFE for its
outstanding work in Central Texas; and

WHEREAS, A nonprofit organization, SAFE is dedicated to 4 5 providing safety, stability, and healing to anyone who has experienced violence and abuse, including survivors of sexual 6 assault, trafficking, domestic violence, and child abuse and 7 neglect; it offers a round-the-clock helpline, shelter and housing 8 to escape immediate risk, and a charter school that is a secure 9 place for daycare and education; in addition, it encompasses an 10 11 on-site sexual assault clinic; among other initiatives, it sponsors 12 a dedicated program for survivors of sex trafficking as well as empower people to 13 prevention programs to choose healthy 14 relationships; and

WHEREAS, SAFE traces its origins back some 45 years, when the 15 Austin Rape Crisis Center and the Center for Battered Women were 16 founded; as those agencies expanded their services, they joined 17 forces in 1998 to establish SafePlace; its mission dovetailed with 18 that of the Austin Children's Shelter, and in more recent years, the 19 20 organizations merged into SAFE to better address the complex issues 21 of violence and abuse; today, SAFE has an annual budget of more than \$20 million, over 350 employees, and thousands of volunteers; its 22 23 prevention and crisis programs operate across multiple campuses and 24 in schools, hospitals, courts, and county offices; and

1 WHEREAS, During Sexual Assault Awareness Month, SAFE is 2 hosting an exhibition titled "What Was I Wearing" to challenge the 3 belief that the clothes a person wears determine their likelihood 4 of experiencing a sexual assault; outfits displayed are accompanied 5 by the stories of survivors, conveying the message that sexual 6 assault is always the sole fault of the perpetrator, not the person 7 who suffered harm; and

8 WHEREAS, Sexual Assault Awareness Month highlights the accomplishments of a movement that has effected positive change, 9 10 including passage of the Violence Against Women Act of 1993, while reminding the public that sexual assault, harassment, and abuse 11 12 remain far too prevalent in our society; through the tireless endeavors of its staff and volunteers, SAFE exemplifies the 13 14 progress the movement has achieved and the commitment to ending the 15 cycle of violence; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas 17 Legislature hereby honor SAFE on the occasion of Sexual Assault 18 Awareness Month 2023 and extend to all those associated with the 19 organization sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further 20 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be 21 prepared for SAFE as an expression of high regard by the Texas House 22 of Representatives.
