R E S O L U T I O N

2 passed away on July 17, 2022, at the age of 79, is being honored at
3 the Carrollton Women's Club Spring Luncheon on April 13, 2023; and

4 WHEREAS, The youngest child of John and Pauline O'Grady,
5 Linda Hoffman was born in Billings, Oklahoma, on July 19, 1942, and
6 she grew up with the companionship of six siblings, Margaret, Pat,
7 Olivia, Eddie, Bert, and Gerald; she went on to marry the love of
8 her life, Leon Hoffman, and together they made their home in such
9 cities as Dallas, Houston, and Austin, before settling in
10 Carrollton, where they spent more than three decades; and

11 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hoffman enjoyed a rewarding career working as a
12 secretary in various school districts throughout the State of
13 Texas, and she eventually retired from the Dallas College
14 Brookhaven Campus; and

15 WHEREAS, An engaged citizen, Mrs. Hoffman was a longtime
16 member of the Carrollton Women's Club, a service-oriented
17 organization that benefits the community by raising money for local
18 charities and for scholarships for area high school girls; over the
19 course of her 24-year membership with the club, she served in
20 numerous leadership roles, including as president,
21 parliamentarian, recording secretary, and corresponding secretary;
22 several years before her passing, she became a resident of the
23 Conservatory At Plano, where she served as an ambassador and on the
24 resident council; and

1 WHEREAS, This beloved woman was a devoted mother to her two
2 children, Gary and Sheri, and through the years, she had the
3 pleasure of welcoming into her family four grandchildren, Ryan,
4 Alyssa, Jacob, and Maggie, as well as a great-granddaughter, Hazel;
5 in her leisure time, she enjoyed reading, quilting, solving
6 crossword puzzles, and playing games with her grandchildren; and

7 WHEREAS, Deeply devoted to her family and her community,
8 Linda Hoffman made a meaningful difference in the lives of her loved
9 ones and fellow citizens alike, and her contributions will be
10 fondly remembered for years to come; now, therefore, be it
