1 WHEREAS, The Texas Southern University cheerleading team
2 realized a historic milestone by being crowned champions at the
3 2023 National Cheerleaders Association & National Dance Alliance
4 College Nationals; and

5 WHEREAS, Joining other top squads from throughout the country
6 in Daytona Beach, Florida, from April 5 through 9, the Tigers
7 delivered an exceptional performance; competing in the Cheer Spirit
8 Rally Division I category, TSU held first place after the
9 preliminary round and went on to triumph in the final round with a
10 total event score of 95.5875, outdistancing its nearest competitor
11 by a margin of nearly 11 points; and

12 WHEREAS, The win was all the more significant because the
13 Tigers are the first team from a Historically Black College and
14 University to claim a national title at the cheerleading
15 championships, and their success is sure to inspire countless young
16 performers across the nation; and

17 WHEREAS, The TSU cheerleaders benefit from the able
18 leadership of head coach Shontrese Comeaux, who has made success at
19 nationals a priority for the team; under her guidance, the Tigers
20 have devoted themselves to building their skills and refining their
21 routines, with valuable contributions being made by each member of
22 the roster; and

24 culmination of countless hours of training and an unwavering
