2 five decades ago, Miss Rodeo Texas has served as a vibrant goodwill
3 ambassador of rodeo and has worked to keep our state's Western
4 heritage alive and flourishing; and

5 WHEREAS, Each year, Miss Rodeo Texas, Inc., hosts a
6 scholarship pageant that consists of horsemanship, appearance, and
7 personality competitions where contestants compete against other
8 finalists from across the state; the organization strives to
9 maintain an enriching environment for all participants and
10 committee members, and the winners are provided with an educational
11 scholarship and support as they represent Texas, the sport of
12 professional rodeo, and the Western apparel industry; furthermore,
13 the winner goes on to compete in the national Miss Rodeo America
14 competition; and

15 WHEREAS, During her reign, Miss Rodeo Texas travels
16 throughout the state educating others on the importance of Texas
17 agriculture and the significant impact that our rich Western
18 heritage has had on our state's development; in addition, she works
19 closely with professional rodeos and rodeo associations to help
20 keep the Western industry thriving; and

21 WHEREAS, The Miss Rodeo Texas program celebrates a
22 significant part of the Lone Star State's storied history, and it
23 provides young women with the opportunity to develop their talents
24 and interpersonal skills and to achieve their educational goals;
