7 successfully ran for the office of mayor in 2021; and

9 roles on a number of boards and commissions for the city, including
10 the Rockwall Economic Development Corporation, the Building Better
11 Roads Bond Committee, and the Rockwall Business and Education

13 Commerce, the Rockwall Rotary Club, Baylor Scott & White Medical
14 Center-Lake Pointe, the YMCA, the Boy Scouts of America, the
15 Rockwall Youth Fair, and CASA, and he is a member of First Baptist
16 Church of Rockwall; and

17 WHEREAS, Mayor Fowler has enjoyed a 30-year career in banking
18 and currently serves as the Rockwall regional president of Lakeside
19 Bank; he earned a bachelor's degree in finance from Louisiana State
20 University and graduated from Southern Methodist University's
21 Southwestern Graduate School of Banking; and

22 WHEREAS, Through his many civic contributions, Kevin Fowler
23 has helped to make Rockwall an even better place in which to live
24 and work, and he may indeed reflect with pride on all that he has

1 accomplished; now, therefore, be it
