WHEREAS, March 31, 2024, marks the celebration of Easter,
which is considered the most holy day of the year in the Christian

WHEREAS, Known also as Resurrection Day, Easter is a time when people around the globe recognize the day that Jesus Christ of Nazareth was raised from the dead after crucifixion on Calvary and three days in the tomb; Christ-followers everywhere reflect with joy on the gospel's enduring message of rebirth, living hope, and eternal life; and
