RESOLUTION

- BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
- 2 Texas, 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, That House Rule 13,
- 3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
- 4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
- 5 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 10 (certain benefits paid by
- 6 the Teacher Retirement System of Texas) to consider and take action
- 7 on the following matters:
- 8 (1) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(2), is suspended to permit
- 9 the committee to omit text not in disagreement in proposed SECTION 1
- 10 of the bill, adding Section 824.703(a), Government Code, by
- 11 striking "an additional" and substituting "a".
- 12 Explanation: The change is necessary to remove unnecessary
- 13 language.
- 14 (2) House Rule 13, Sections 9(a)(3) and (4), are suspended
- 15 to permit the committee to add text on a matter not in disagreement
- 16 and not included in either the house or senate version of the bill
- in proposed SECTION 1 of the bill, by adding Section 824.703(c)(3),
- 18 Government Code, to read as follows:
- 19 (3) is an alternate payee under Section 804.005, to be
- 20 eligible for the adjustment:
- 21 (A) the annuitant must be living on the effective
- 22 <u>date of the adjustment; and</u>
- 23 (B) the effective date of the annuitant's
- 24 election to receive the annuity payment was on or before August 31,

- 1 2020.
- 2 Explanation: The change is necessary to clarify that an
- 3 alternate payee makes the election and specify that an alternate
- 4 payee must be living on the effective date of the cost-of-living
- 5 adjustment required by the proposed bill.
- 6 (3) House Rule 13, Sections 9(a)(3) and (4), are suspended
- 7 to permit the committee to add text on a matter not in disagreement
- 8 and not included in either the house or senate version of the bill
- 9 by adding proposed SECTION 2(c) of the bill to read as follows:
- 10 (c) The amount of the supplemental payment is equal to:
- 11 (1) \$7,500, if the annuitant is at least 75 years of
- 12 age on any day of the calendar month before the calendar month in
- 13 which the Teacher Retirement System of Texas issues the
- 14 supplemental payment; or
- 15 (2) \$2,400, if the annuitant is:
- 16 (A) at least 70 years of age but younger than 75
- 17 years of age on any day of the calendar month before the calendar
- 18 month in which the Teacher Retirement System of Texas issues the
- 19 supplemental payment; and
- 20 (B) not subject to Subdivision (1) of this
- 21 subsection.
- 22 Explanation: The change is necessary to prescribe different
- 23 amounts for the supplemental payment required by the proposed bill
- 24 based on the age of the annuitant eligible for the payment.
