1 WHEREAS, The city of Georgetown is celebrating the 175th
2 anniversary of its founding in 2023, and this occasion provides a
3 fitting opportunity to reflect on the history of this vibrant
4 Central Texas city; and

5 WHEREAS, Established in 1848 as the county seat of Williamson
6 County, the city was named after George Washington Glasscock, who
7 donated land for the site, along with his partner, Thomas B. Huling;
8 the community grew in importance with the establishment of
9 Southwestern University in 1873 and the completion of a rail line to
10 the town five years later, and the early economy centered around
11 agriculture and cattle, with a cotton boom starting in the 1880s;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, Currently one of the fastest-growing cities in the
14 country, Georgetown is home to more than 86,000 residents; despite
15 its rapid expansion, the city has retained its historic charm,
16 carefully preserving the Classical Revival and Late Victorian
17 architecture of the Williamson County Courthouse Historic
18 District; the city also features a wide range of popular
19 attractions, including the Georgetown Palace Theatre, the
20 Williamson Museum, Inner Space Cavern, and Blue Hole Park; and

21 WHEREAS, The citizens of Georgetown are working to safeguard
22 the best of their past while building a future of expanding
23 opportunity, and it is a pleasure to honor their contributions to
24 the story of the Lone Star State on the occasion of this notable
