4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 264.107, Family Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
7	(h) The department by rule shall establish guidelines for
8	the placement of a child in a residential child-care facility at
9	which a preventable death, as defined by Section 264.501, of a child
10	in the managing conservatorship of the department occurred.
11	SECTION 2. Section 42.046, Human Resources Code, is amended
12	by adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
13	(e-1) The commission shall deny an application under this
14	section if:
15	(1) the applicant operated a residential child-care
16	facility at which a preventable death, as defined by Section
17	264.501, Family Code, of a child in the managing conservatorship of
18	the department occurred; and
19	(2) the commission terminated a contract with the
20	residential child-care facility as the result of the preventable
21	death.
22	SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
23	42.046, Human Resources Code, apply only to an application for a
24	license submitted to the Health and Human Services Commission on or

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1 after the effective date of this Act.

2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
