10	interest to use funds in the economically distressed areas account
11	to provide financial assistance for the costs associated with
12	backup power generators for facilities of public water supply and
13	sanitary sewer systems.
14	(b) A political subdivision may use financial assistance to
15	pay for the installation, maintenance, operation, and fueling of a

- pay for the installation, maintenance, operation, and fueling of a backup power generator for a facility of a public water supply and sanitary sewer system.
- 18 (c) Assistance under this section shall only be provided to
  19 political subdivisions that demonstrate an inability to pay for the
  20 installation, maintenance, operation, and fueling of a backup power
  21 generator described by Subsection (b) in accordance with board
  22 rules. If the board determines that a political subdivision to
  23 which assistance has been provided is ineligible to receive the
  24 assistance, the board may seek reimbursement from the political

- 2 (d) The board shall adopt rules to implement this section.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
