- (d) A statute that regulates or prohibits abortion may not 8
- 9 be construed to authorize the imposition or incurrence of criminal,
- civil, or administrative penalties or liability on a pregnant 10
- individual on whom an abortion is performed, induced, or attempted. 11
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 171.206(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 (b) This subchapter may not be construed to:
- authorize the initiation of a cause of action 15
- 16 against or the prosecution of a <u>pregnant individual</u> [woman] on whom
- an abortion is performed or induced or attempted to be performed or 17
- induced in violation of this subchapter; 18
- (2) wholly or partly repeal, either expressly or by 19
- 20 implication, any other statute that regulates or prohibits
- 21 abortion[, including Chapter 6-1/2, Title 71, Revised Statutes]; or
- 22 (3) restrict a political subdivision from regulating
- 23 or prohibiting abortion in a manner that is at least as stringent as
- 24 the laws of this state.

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 171.207(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 (b) Subsection (a) may not be construed to:
- 4 (1) legalize the conduct prohibited by this subchapter
 - [or by Chapter 6-1/2, Title 71, Revised Statutes];
- 6 (2) limit in any way or affect the availability of a
- 7 remedy established by Section 171.208; or
- 8 (3) limit the enforceability of any other laws that
- 9 regulate or prohibit abortion.
- SECTION 4. Chapter 6-1/2, Title 71, Revised Statutes, is
- 11 repealed.

- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
