- 8 BENEFITS AND POLICIES
- Sec. 83.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: 9
- "Employee" means an individual who is employed by (1) 10
- an employer for compensation. 11
- 12 (2) "Employer" means a person who employs one or more
- 13 employees.
- 14 (3) "Employment benefit" means anything of value that
- 15 an employee receives from an employer beyond regular salary or
- wages. 16
- 17 Sec. 83.002. PROHIBITION AGAINST MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY
- REQUIRING CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT BENEFITS OR POLICIES. 18 (a)
- 19 municipality or county may not adopt or enforce an ordinance,
- order, rule, regulation, or policy requiring any terms of 20
- employment that exceed or conflict with federal or state law 21
- 22 relating to any form of employment leave, hiring practices,
- employment benefits, or scheduling practices. 23
- 24 (b) Any provision of an ordinance, order, rule, regulation,

- 1 or policy that violates Subsection (a) is void and unenforceable.

- 7 (3) employment and safety protections afforded by
- 8 state and federal law to employees and prospective employees;
- 9 <u>(4) an ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy</u>
- 10 relating to terms of employment in contracts or agreements entered
- 11 into between a private entity, including an organization
- 12 representing city employees or county employees, and a governmental

- 16 (5) a contract or agreement relating to terms of

- 19 SECTION 2. Chapter 83, Labor Code, as added by this Act,
- 20 applies to an ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy adopted
- 21 before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
