(b) Mental and behavioral telehealth services provided 17 under this section must be: 18 (1) accessible electronically through the use of a 19 computer or telephone application; and 20 21 (2) available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. 22 (c) Mobile mental and behavioral health intervention 23 services provided under this section must be: 24 (1) deployed to the location of the child or the

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1	relative or other designated caregiver requiring intervention

4	(d) Services described by this section may only be provided

7	(2) a licensed marriage and family therapist, as

22	(g) The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to

24	SECTION 2. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective
25	date of this Act, the commissioner of the Department of Family and
26	Protective Services shall adopt the rules necessary to implement

8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
