A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the prohibition on lobbying by certain elected 3 officers. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 141.001, Election Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (e) and (f) to read 6 as follows: 7 (a) To be eligible to be a candidate for, or elected or 8 9 appointed to, a public elective office in this state, a person must: (1) be a United States citizen; 10 11 (2) be 18 years of age or older on the first day of the 12 term to be filled at the election or on the date of appointment, as 13 applicable; 14 (3) have not been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be: 15 16 (A) totally mentally incapacitated; or partially mentally incapacitated without the 17 (B) right to vote; 18 have not been finally convicted of a felony from 19 (4)20 which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from 21 the resulting disabilities; 22 (5) have resided continuously in the state for 12 23 months and in the territory from which the office is elected for six months immediately preceding the following date: 24

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governing body of a political subdivision with a population of 1 50,000 or less, provided that the presiding officer does not 2 3 receive a salary or wage for that office. 4 (f) For purposes of Subsection (e), a presiding officer or 5 other officeholder is not considered to have received a salary or wage if the officeholder refuses to accept a salary or wage offered 6 7 or budgeted for that office. SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 305, Government Code, is 8 amended by adding Section 305.0031 to read as follows: 9 Sec. 305.0031. REGISTRATION BY CERTAIN ELECTED OFFICERS 10 PROHIBITED. (a) An individual may not register under this chapter 11 12 if the individual is a: (1) member of Congress; 13 14 (2) member of the legislature; or 15 (3) statewide officeholder. (b) An individual's registration under this chapter expires 16 17 on the date the individual takes an office described by Subsection (a). 18 SECTION 3. Chapter 601, Government Code, is amended by 19 adding Section 601.010 to read as follows: 20 21 Sec. 601.010. REGISTRATION AS LOBBYIST BY ELECTED OFFICER PROHIBITED. (a) An individual may not qualify for a public 22 elective office if the individual is required to register as a 23 24 lobbyist under Chapter 305. (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to: 25 26 (1) an office for which the federal or state 27 constitution prescribes exclusive qualification requirements;

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(2) an office of a political subdivision with a 1 population of 150,000 or less, other than the office of presiding 2 officer of the governing body of the political subdivision, 3 provided that the officeholder does not receive a salary or wage for 4 5 that office; or 6 (3) the office of the presiding officer of the governing body of a political subdivision with a population of 7 50,000 or less, provided that the presiding officer does not 8 receive a salary or wage for that office. 9 (c) For purposes of Subsection (b), a presiding officer or 10 other of ficeholder is not considered to have received a salary or 11 12 wage if the officeholder refuses to accept a salary or wage offered or budgeted for that office. 13 SECTION 4. Section 141.001(a), Election Code, as amended by 14 15 this Act, and Section 601.010, Government Code, as added by this Act, apply only to the eligibility and qualification requirements 16 17 for a candidate or officer whose term of office will begin on or

after the effective date of this Act. The eligibility and qualification requirements for a candidate or officer whose term of office will begin before the effective date of this Act are governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect January 14, 2025.

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
